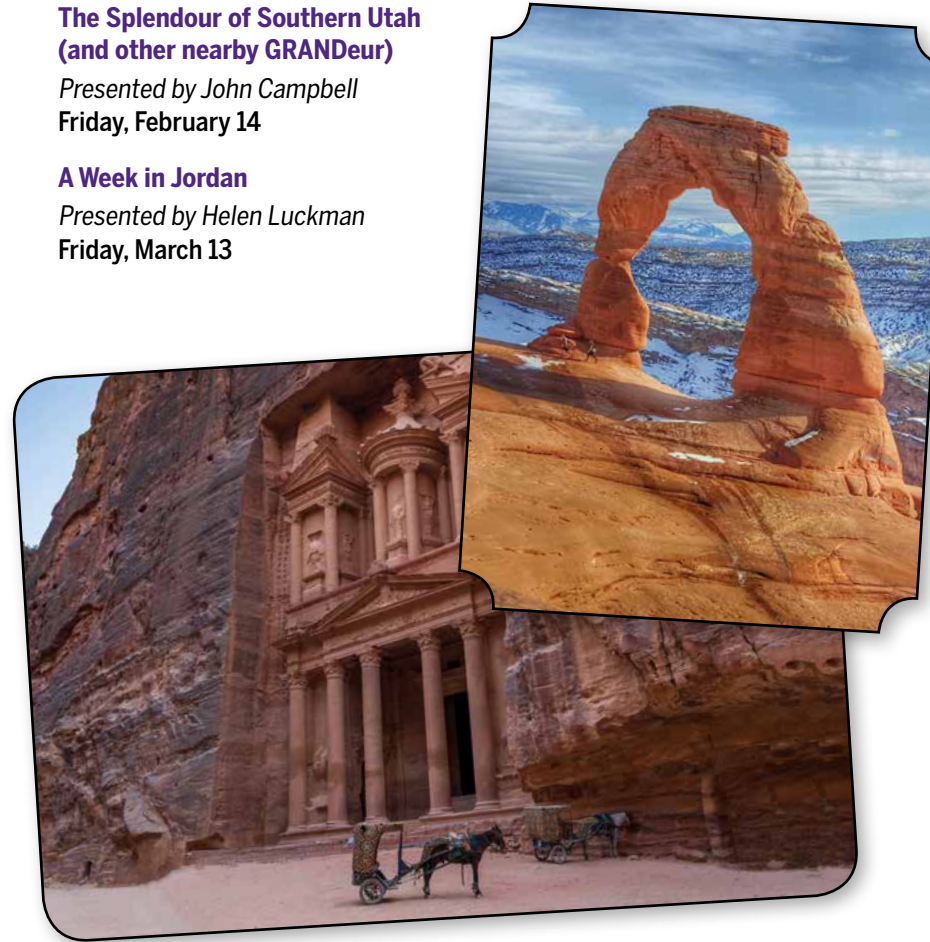

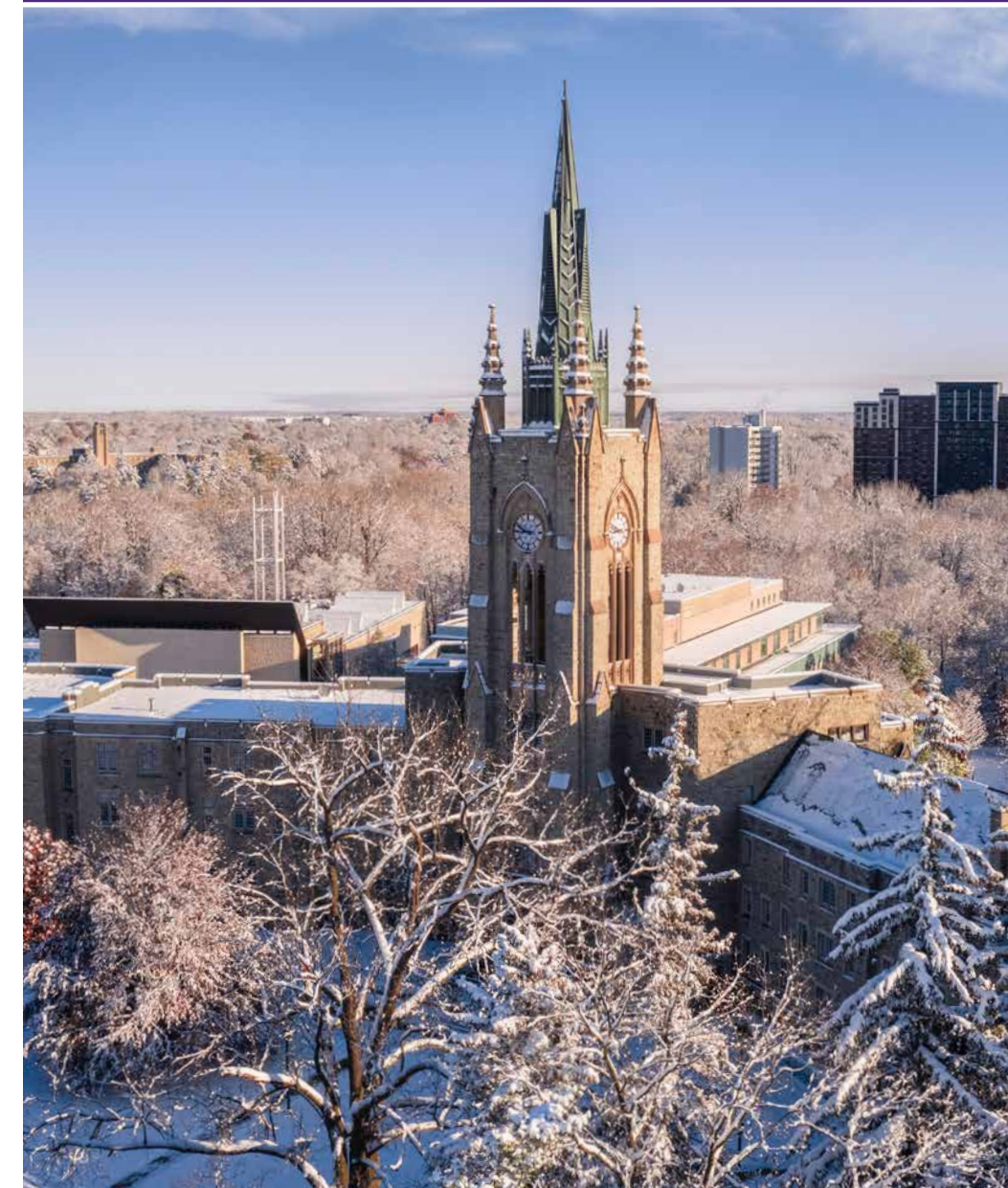

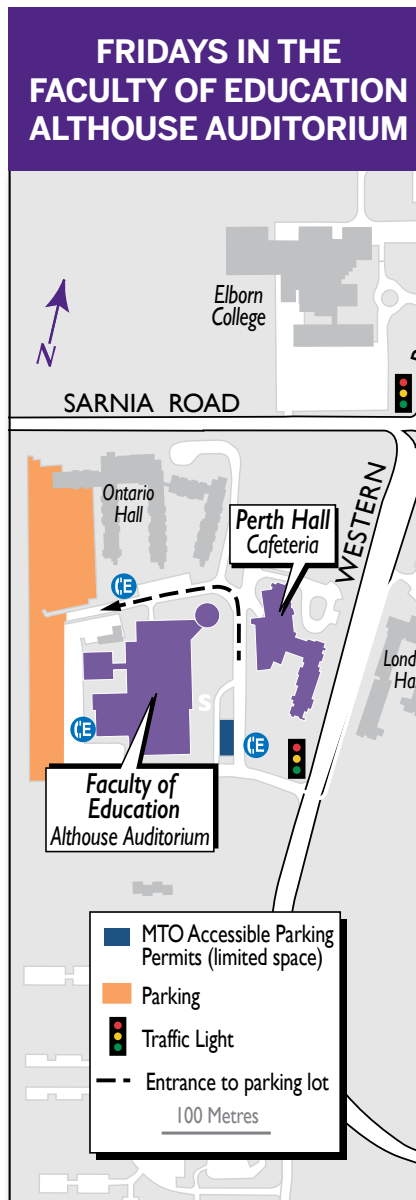
Parking
